

Sidney, Nebraska, July 9, 2019 A Fair Housing City

A meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Sidney, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 7:15 P.M. on July 9, 2019 in the Council Room. Present were: Mayor Gallaway and Council Members: Arterburn, Sherman, Radcliffe and Olsen. Others present: City Manager Sadler, City Attorney Leef and City Clerk Anthony. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in *The Sidney Sun Telegraph*, the designated method for giving notice, a copy of the proof of publication being attached to these minutes. Advance notice of the meeting was also given to the members of the City Council and a copy of their acknowledgment of receipt of notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the City Council. All proceedings shown hereafter were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Gallaway informed the public of the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

Arterburn moved, Sherman seconded "That the minutes of the meetings held on June 25 and 27, 2019 be approved as printed." Roll call vote: Yeas: All council members present.

The City Clerk read Ordinance No. 1811 by title for the third time. Olsen moved, Sherman seconded "That Ordinance No. 1811 be finally passed." Roll call vote: Yeas: All council members present. The passage and adoption of said ordinance having been concurred in by a majority of all members of the City Council was declared passed and adopted and the Mayor in the presence of the City Council signed and affixed his signature thereto.
