

Sidney, Nebraska, October 8, 2019 A Fair Housing City

A meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Sidney, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 7:15 P.M. on October 8, 2019 in the Council Room. Present were: Mayor Gallaway and Council Members: Arterburn, Sherman, Olsen and Radcliffe. Others present: City Manager Sadler, City Attorney Leef and City Clerk Anthony. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in *The Sidney Sun Telegraph*, the designated method for giving notice, a copy of the proof of publication being attached to these minutes. Advance notice of the meeting was also given to the members of the City Council and a copy of their acknowledgment of receipt of notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the City Council. All proceedings shown hereafter were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Gallaway informed the public of the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

Arterburn moved, Radcliffe seconded "That the minutes of the September 24, 2019 meeting be approved as printed." Roll call vote: Yeas: All council members present. Abstain: Olsen.

City Clerk Anthony read Ordinance No. 1813 by title for the second time as follows: "That the Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SIDNEY, NEBRASKA, TO AMEND CHAPTER 618 "ANIMALS" OF THE GENERAL OFFENSES CODE OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SIDNEY, NEBRASKA TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT FOR LICENCING ANIMALS WITH THE CITY OF SIDNEY; TO MODIFY THE CHARGES FOR BOARD AND IMPOUND; TO MODIFY THE LENGTH OF TIME A DOG AT LARGE WILL BE IMPOUNDED; TO MODIFY THE TIME REQUIREMENTS REGARDING RABIES VACCINATIONS; TO REPEAL ANY ORDINANCE OR PART OF ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE".

City Manager Sadler explained the "speed limits" ordinance. Radcliffe moved, Sherman seconded "That the Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SIDNEY, NEBRASKA, AMENDING SECTIONS 434.04 AND 434.05 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SIDNEY, NEBRASKA, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SPEED LIMITS IN PARKS AND RECREATION GROUNDS; SPEED LIMITS NEAR SCHOOLS; SPEED LIMITS GENERALLY; EXCEPTIONS AND OTHER SPEED LIMITS FOR STATED STREETS AND ROADS; AND REPEALING SECTIONS 434.04 AND 434.05 OF THE CURRENT CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SIDNEY, NEBRASKA," be designated as Ordinance No. 1814." Roll call vote: Yeas: All council members present. There was no motion to suspend requiring the ordinance to be read by title three different days. The Clerk read the Ordinance by title.

Economic Development Director Melissa Norgard presented a request to re-designate the slum and blight area in Sidney. Arterburn moved, Olsen seconded "That RESOLUTION NO. 20191001 be passed and adopted. Roll call vote: Yeas: All council members present.

Economic Development Director Melissa Norgard presented a request to apply for a Community Development Block Grant Planning Tourism Grant. Arterburn moved, Radcliffe seconded "That Economic Development Director Melissa Norgard's request to apply for a CDBG for a Planning Tourism Grant be approved." Roll call vote: Yeas: All council members present

Melissa Norgard read the MANUFACTURING MONTH PROCLAMATION and Mayor Gallaway signed same.

Arterburn moved, Sherman seconded “That the following claims for September 2019, are hereby approved and should be paid as provided by law out of the respective funds in the city treasury.” (Abbreviation for claims: bd bond, ct contract, du dues, eq equipment, ex expenses, in insurance, re reimbursements, sa salaries, se service, su supplies, tt travel/training, tx tax, ut utilities) Roll call vote: Yeas: All council members present.
