

Sidney, Nebraska, May 16, 2017 A Fair Housing City

A special meeting for the purpose of a Goal Setting Session with the Mayor & Council of the City of Sidney, Nebraska, was convened in open & public session at 6:30 P.M. on May 16, 2017 in the Meeting Room of the Hampton Inn, 635 Cabela Drive, Sidney, Nebraska.
