

Sidney, Nebraska, July 10, 2018 A Fair Housing City

A meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Sidney, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 7:19 P.M. on July 10, 2018 in the Council Room. Mike Palmer, Superintendent of the Electric Department asked for approval for staff to enter into contract negotiations with Exponential Engineering Company for a ten year Electric System Planning Analysis for a cost of Not-to-Exceed \$85,950. Services that were requested are: Master Plan, Electrical System Review, Sectionalizing Study, and an Arc Flash Analysis. Additional work to the listed ones was for On-call engineering services that may be needed in the future. Gaston moved, Utley seconded "That the staff be authorized to negotiate a contract with Exponential Engineering Company for the 10-Year Electric System Planning & Analysis."
